














Faculty member talks to Dept. Chair & Faculty Colleagues,

then with dean about new program idea.

Dean talks with VPI and informs Division Departments.



After review by Department and Dean,

Faculty Member announces the degree and/or certificate program idea

to the College Curriculum Committee.



Curriculum
Committee Chair
announces the degree
and/or certificate
program idea

to the Academic Senate.



VPI announces the degree and/or certificate program idea to

Program Placement Council (PPC),

which approves program placement in the District,

before course and program development begins.

*Based on one or more:

- a. Program review/unit planning
- b. Advisory committee feedback
- c. External environmental scanning of the educational and/or workforce development community
