

# CCC Summary Report for Colleges Participating in the Fall 2012 Distance Education Student Satisfaction Survey (7-16-13)

Survey: 2012 Fall DE Student Satisfaction Survey

The Chancellor's Office has reported the growth of distance education in the California Community College (CCC) System to the Board of Governors (BOG) every two years since 1997 and growth has increased significantly. Currently, more than 27% of all CCC students take at least one distance education courses each term. In 2011-12, nearly 10.1% of all FTES in the System was generated through distance education. In that same year, 50 colleges reported having over 500 AA/AS/Certificate of Achievement programs available via distance education.

One area of interest of the BOG is "Student Satisfaction" with distance education. It is important to gather feedback from students as a part of distance education program development and evaluation. Colleges often focus a great deal of time and energy on developing new distance education courses and programs, but are often less effective when it comes to measuring distance education course and program outcomes. In January 2013, the Chancellor's Office initiated a distance education student satisfaction survey of students who enrolled in and completed a distance education course in the 2012 Fall Term.


The online survey addressed interactions based on the typology of online interaction identified by Moore & Kearsley (2005, 1996), Hanna, Dudka & Runlee (2000) and Palloff & Pratt (2001) and includes the following areas:

- learner-content interaction
- learner-instructor interaction
- learner-learner interaction
- learner-technology interaction
- general interaction

There were 44 colleges that participated in the survey. The summary results for those 44 colleges are included on the following pages. Each participating college also got their individual results for comparison and detailed responses for use in local research.









### 7. Is the course or workshop required before you can take a distance education course at the college or is it voluntary?





## 7. What type of orientation course/workshop did you complete?









### 12. Please select the type of instructional delivery for the distance education course you identified in question # 11.





# 13. Please select if the course identified in question #11 was in real time or delayed time.

































































### 50. Computers are a good aids to learning





#### 51. I consider myself a skilled computer user





#### 52. I am very satisfied with this online course





#### 53. I would like to take another online course





## 54. This distance education course met my learning needs





#### 55. I would recommend this course to others










